

The U.S. Navy Announces Availability of the Draft Environmental Impact Statement for Bremerton Waterfront Infrastructure Improvements at Puget Sound Naval Shipyard and Intermediate Maintenance Facility, Naval Base Kitsap-Bremerton



Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act, the U.S. Navy has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to evaluate the potential environmental impacts of constructing a new multi-mission dry dock and associated waterfront infrastructure improvements at Puget Sound Naval Shipyard and Intermediate Maintenance Facility (PSNS & IMF) and relocating some shipyard functions to Naval Base Kitsap-Bangor. PSNS & IMF is located on Naval Base Kitsap-Bremerton in Washington state. The Navy is accepting comments during a 45-day public review and comment period from July 18 to Sept. 3, 2025. The Navy invites your comments on the environmental analysis presented in the Draft EIS, and on the project's potential to affect historic properties pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. The input received during the public comment period will be considered in the development of the Final EIS. The Navy welcomes your participation in the EIS process. SUBMIT COMMENTS:
